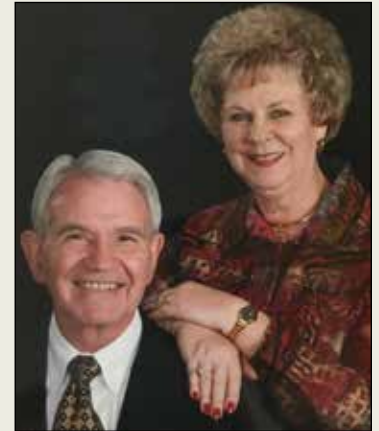
# Confident Giving to Help Children
