Catawba Valley Healthy Families

Catawba Valley Healthy Families is a voluntary home visitation program designed to empower parents to support their child(ren)'s healthy development by establishing a nurturing and safe home environment and encouraging parents to set and achieve goals specific to the hopes and dreams they have for their families.

Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Iredell,
and McDowell counties**

Who can receive help?

Families expecting a baby, or who have an infant under 3 months of age. This program is designed to serve ALL parents, first-time or seasoned. The home visitor will work with the entire family, including older siblings. One or both parents (or primary caregivers) can choose to enroll in CVHF services, participation is voluntary. Families can remain enrolled until their child's fifth birthday, though many families complete the program in three years.

Cost

The program is a **free service** that is grant funded.

How does Catawba Valley Healthy Families support families?

Upon enrolling, families are supported by a Family Support Specialist (FSS). This individual is qualified and experienced in understanding family concerns and parenting challenges and is trained to assist with all aspects of family life. The FSS will provide current information on a wide variety of topics related to healthy child development, links to beneficial community resources, and encouragement as families work toward meeting their goals. Home visits are always scheduled at a time that is convenient for the family.

How will having a Family Support Specialist benefit families and their baby?

Your FSS will share information to help:

- ▶ **Recognize their baby's needs**
- ▶ **Take care of their baby while the parents/caregivers also take care of themselves**
- ▶ **Understand their baby's development and know what to expect as the baby grows**
- ▶ **Foster their baby's development using developmentally appropriate activities**
- ▶ **"Baby proof" their home to make it safe**

Your FSS will lend support and share information on issues such as:

- ▶ **Effective discipline**
- ▶ **Community services to help meet the family's goals and/or needs**
- ▶ **Employment**
- ▶ **Ways for new parents to continue their education**
- ▶ **Transportation**
- ▶ **Budgeting and finances**
- ▶ **Strengthening the relationship with a spouse/partner**



Finding help and hope

Being a first-time mother is never easy. And it's even more challenging when you're just 16 years old and don't have a solid relationship with the baby's father. But that was Teena's situation.

And to add to the difficulties, she was recovering from cancer and still attending follow-up appointments when she discovered she was pregnant.

Early in her pregnancy, Teena started working with the Catawba Valley Healthy Families (CVHF) program. The home visitor helped her understand the changes she was experiencing during her pregnancy as well as learning to identify important infant developmental milestones.

Because Teena had dropped out of high school due to her illness, the home visitor encouraged her to complete her GED. They had many discussions about the benefits of completing her high school

diploma, and after Jayden was born, she started working toward her GED.

Today the family is doing great. Teena and her boyfriend got married when Jayden was about 6 months old, and they have been in a stable relationship ever since.

Now, Jayden is a healthy 3-year-old who has stayed on track with his development. He is in Pre-K two days per week and can sing the entire ABC song by himself. Jayden's father works full-time and his mother works part-time and is one test away from completing her GED. Once she completes her GED, Teena plans to enroll in college courses. They have lots of local family support, including one of Jayden's grandmothers who babysits a couple of days per week.

As Teena and her husband have learned, parenting is never easy, but it's manageable with the right education and supports like CVHF by their side.
